

# M&P OCCUPATIONAL GUIDELINE

## JOB FAMILY: COUNSELLORS/PSYCHOLOGISTS Level A, Pay Grade 9

<b>LEVEL DEFINITION</b>	This level covers positions responsible for providing personal, academic, career, and medical counselling to individuals and groups.
<b>TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES</b>	May include: providing personal, academic, career, and medical counselling to individuals, couples, families and groups; applying relaxation techniques to clients after invasive medical investigations; facilitating support groups; and writing client reports.
<b>DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY</b>	Makes professional and technical decisions and recommendations on all aspects of the work.  Accountable for the delivery of professional standards of practice.
<b>SUPERVISION RECEIVED</b>	Works within professional guidelines. Informed technical guidance is available.
<b>SUPERVISION EXERCISED</b>	Not required.
<b>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</b>	Master's degree in Counselling Psychology or a related field. Eligible for professional certification in British Columbia. Minimum of three years of relevant experience in clinical counselling, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
