## JOB FAMILY: GRAPHIC DESIGN & ILLUSTRATION Level A, Pay Grade 5

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions responsible for providing graphic design, art, and publication layout services.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: providing graphic design, art and layout services; advising clients regarding graphic design and media; selecting design format, materials and processes; preparing scientific illustrations requiring finishing art techniques; interpreting materials and preparing data for graph presentations; reviewing layouts, sketches and final plans for production; and evaluating artistic media to determine design, materials and process requirements.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes decisions regarding graphic design format, methodology and techniques to be used.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works under general direction. Work is reviewed in terms of quality and conformance with standards.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	May direct the work of technical support staff.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Three year Graphic Design program. Minimum of two years of related experience, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
