M&P OCCUPATIONAL GUIDELINE

JOB FAMILY: HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT Level D, Pay Grade 12

LEVEL DEFINITION	Positions at this level are responsible for the successful operation of an occupational health and safety division, a research health and safety division, or an environmental safety division that is University-wide.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: developing, promoting and managing multiple diverse programs within a division area that are University-wide; providing leadership and direction to multiple professional staff; providing leadership in the identification of significant impacts and developing objectives and targets to reduce these impacts; promoting awareness by developing appropriate strategies and work plans.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Accountable for the success and operations of multiple diverse programs with a division area with University-wide impact.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works in full latitude within a mandate, under direction of the head of the unit.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Full management of staff, including hiring, evaluating performance, disciplining and termination.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Undergraduate degree in a relevant discipline. Minimum of six years experience including at least four years in an area of specialization as well as management experience, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
