JOB FAMILY: INFORMATION SYSTEMS & TECHNOLOGY Level F, Pay Grade 15

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions responsible for providing management of a major functional area of a centralized complex campus-wide information system or service.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: providing overall management of a major functional area of a complex campus-wide information system; planning, implementing and managing large-scale projects; designing and developing software and business applications for campus-wide systems; and advising other professionals in the design and selection of equipment and establishment of department policies.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes decisions regarding the management of a major functional area of a centralized complex campus-wide information system or service.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works within broad policies and strategic plans under senior administrative direction. Work is reviewed for achievement of broad long-term goals.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Manages staff directly and indirectly through subordinate managers.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Post-graduate degree. Minimum of ten years of related experience including at least four years of managerial experience plus three years of specialized experience in the design and implementation of major computer systems, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
