JOB FAMILY: SECURITY Level D, Pay Grade 15

LEVEL DEFINITION	Covers positions that provide leadership and direction in the management and delivery of security services for people, property and assets.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: providing strategic guidance in the development and implementation of new service models, mechanisms, policies, processes and procedures that support safety and security; providing overall delivery and co-ordination of services; providing community – oriented safety and security service that includes a proactive approach to dealing with safety challenging issues and events; establishing policies, procedures and services; negotiating with internal and external parties regarding provision of services.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Decisions ensure the safety and security of people, property and assets.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works under executive direction; results reviewed for achievement of overall and strategic objectives.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Plans, directs, reviews and develops the activities of professionals and support staff through sub managers.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	University graduation in a related discipline. Minimum of seven years of experience in a complex, service related organization.
