JOB FAMILY: STATISTICAL ANALYSIS Level B, Pay Grade 10

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions that are engaged in statistical modelling and designing statistical methodologies.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: designing and developing statistical software; coordinating and facilitating database development and statistical analyses; performing statistical modelling; developing merged core datasets; being responsible for the security and integrity of the databases; writing research proposals and publications.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Exercises professional judgment and initiative in assessing design and testing approaches. Accountable for the delivery and reliability of their work.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works independently under general direction.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	May give technical guidance or manage members of the research teams.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Post-graduate degree in Statistics. Minimum of three years of related experience in research analysis, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
