LEVEL DEFINITION	The level covers positions that provide expertise and leadership in research designs. May include: providing expertise and leadership in the planning stages of research; introducing new statistical methodologies and study designs; conducting integrative analyses on large datasets.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Exercises leadership and professional judgment in the overall data capturing and analysis. Accountable for the generation of quality data that may have policy implications. Works under administrative direction. Results reviewed for achievement of overall objectives.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	May be required to manage junior statisticians or members of the research teams.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Post-graduate degree in Statistics. Minimum of five years of related experience in integrative analysis, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
