M&P OCCUPATIONAL GUIDELINE

JOB FAMILY: MEDIA SERVICES Level A, Pay Grade 5

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions responsible for managing the production and delivery of multi-media materials and services to clients.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: managing the production of multi-media materials and presentations; developing and implementing project plans and schedules; developing production budgets; consulting with clients regarding the design of educational and electronic media projects; developing video programs and multimedia materials for use in promotions, classrooms, labs and independent learning packages; developing concepts and writing copy for promotional materials; and conducting product seminars and presentations.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes decisions regarding the development of multimedia projects, schedules and budgets.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works under general direction within guidelines and policies. Work is reviewed in terms of adherence to guidelines and industry standards.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Manages staff, consultants and crew involved in a multimedia project.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Two year diploma in multimedia and broadcast production. Minimum of three years of related experience, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
