JOB FAMILY: BUSINESS OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT Level B, Pay Grade 8

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions of defined scope responsible for managing a localized business operation.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: managing a localized business operation; developing and implementing marketing plans and programmes; managing operating budgets; developing plans for custodial services and building maintenance services; negotiating pricing with vendors to supply products and services; developing policies and procedures; managing sales and inventory control processes; and identifying new product lines.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes decisions regarding marketing plans, products and pricing.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works autonomously under general managerial direction. Work is reviewed in terms of sound business practice, profitability and achievement of specific objectives.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Manages staff and is responsible for hire, discipline, evaluation and termination.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Undergraduate degree in a relevant discipline. Minimum of three years of related experience, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
