

# M&P OCCUPATIONAL GUIDELINE

## JOB FAMILY: MUSEUM

### Level F, Pay Grade 12

<b>LEVEL DEFINITION</b>	Positions at this level directs industrial research, and serves as an industry expert.
<b>TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES</b>	In addition to performing typical responsibilities at Level E, overseeing the work of a group of high-level curators and designer, directing industrial research, and deciding outcomes of industrial research products released to trade market.
<b>DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY</b>	Provides strategic direction and decision making for the overall operation and management of the entire unit.
<b>SUPERVISION RECEIVED</b>	Works under direction of senior administration with full professional latitude. Work is reviewed in terms of achievement of academic and professional standards within assigned specialization and adherence to the museum's mandate.
<b>SUPERVISION EXERCISED</b>	Manages, recruits, mentors and trains staff and supervises senior staff through direct and indirect reports.
<b>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</b>	Master's degree in a relevant discipline. Minimum of eight years of related experience, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
